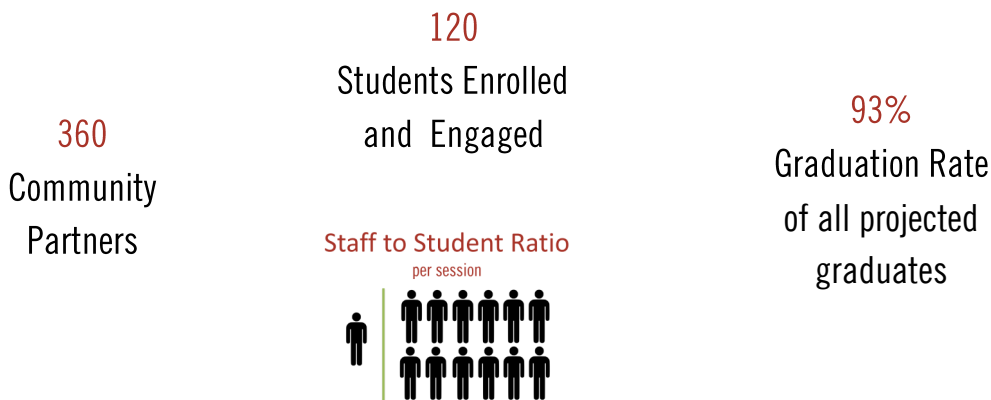


Ombudsman Charter Northeast

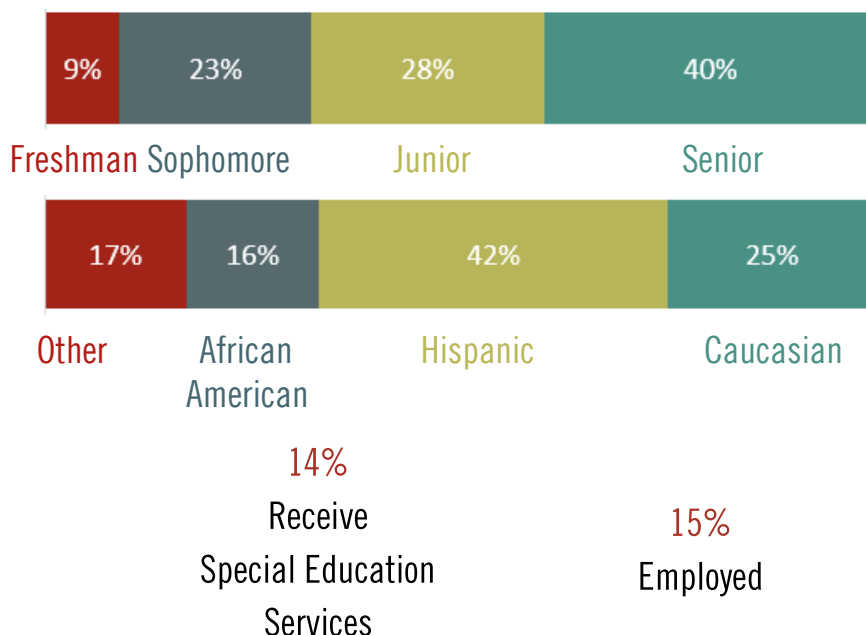
>> Our Program

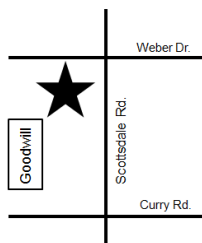
